Gallup's Michael Sage Wins 40 Under 40 in Economic Development Award

Gallup, NM – Michael Sage, Deputy Director for the Greater Gallup Economic Development Corporation (GGEDC) and Regional Economic Development Manager for the Northwest New Mexico Council of Governments (NWNMCOG) has been announced as a recipient of the 2023 Economic Development 40 Under 40 Award, the national biennial award recognizing rising stars under 40 years old in the economic development industry.
