STATE REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

Mutual Domestic Water Consumers Associations (MDWCA) are organized and accountable to the laws of the Sanitary Projects Act (SPA). Provisions of the SPA require that MDWCAs remain in regulatory compliance with the NM Secretary of State, the Open Meetings Act under the Attorney General's Office, the Governor's Executive Order 2013-006 which is regulated by DFA-LGD and the State Auditor's Office, the Safe Drinking Water Act as regulated by the New Mexico **Environment Department, NM Tax and Revenue and the NM Office of the State Engineer.**

Management and accountability of these laws fall under the responsibility of the Board of Directors which are elected by the MDWCA's membership. According to the governing documents of MDWCAs as outlined in the SPA, the Board of Directors oversee the Technical, Managerial and Financial condition of their water
