

# REGION 11 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH REGIONAL PLAN

## Overview & Timeline

### About the Plan

Senate Bill 3, the **Behavioral Health Reform & Investment Act (BHRIA)**, passed during the 2025 New Mexico Legislative Session, calls for rebuilding and strengthening the state's behavioral health system through a regional approach. Region 11—covering McKinley and San Juan Counties, including Native American nations and communities—has been tasked with developing a **multi-year Behavioral Health Regional Plan** by **June 2026**.

The plan will identify up to **five regional behavioral health priorities** and propose strategies and investments to improve access, coordination, and outcomes across the behavioral health continuum.

### Key Goals

- Strengthen and expand behavioral health and substance use services.
- Build regional collaboration among providers, tribal partners, and local governments.
- Develop actionable, fundable strategies for long-term system improvement.
- Ensure community voices guide priorities and investments.
