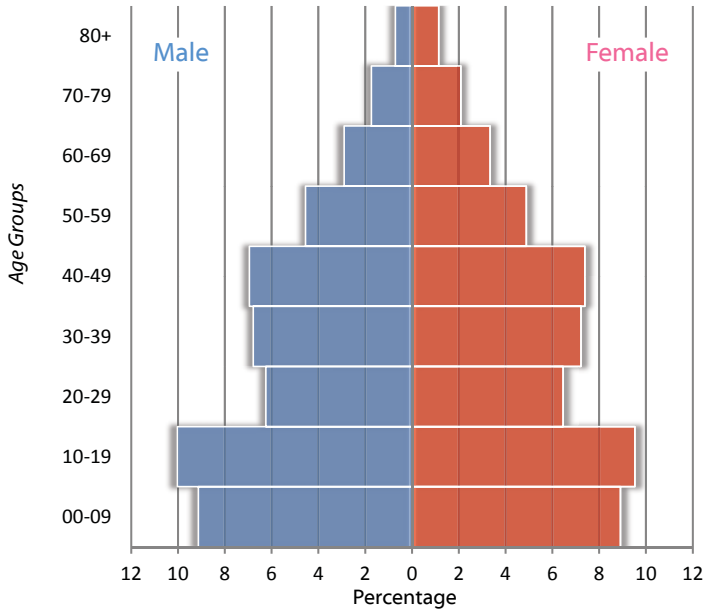

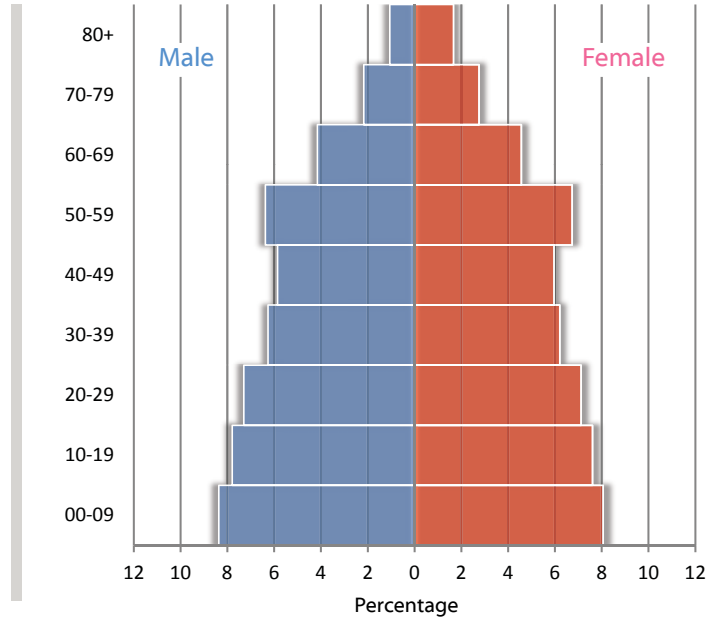

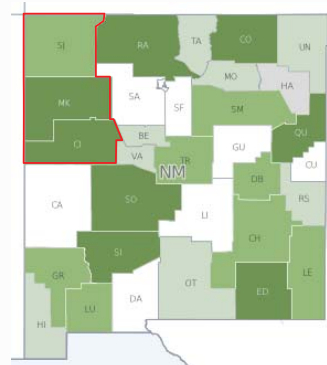

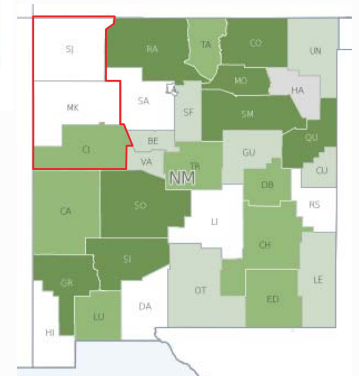
### MORTALITY

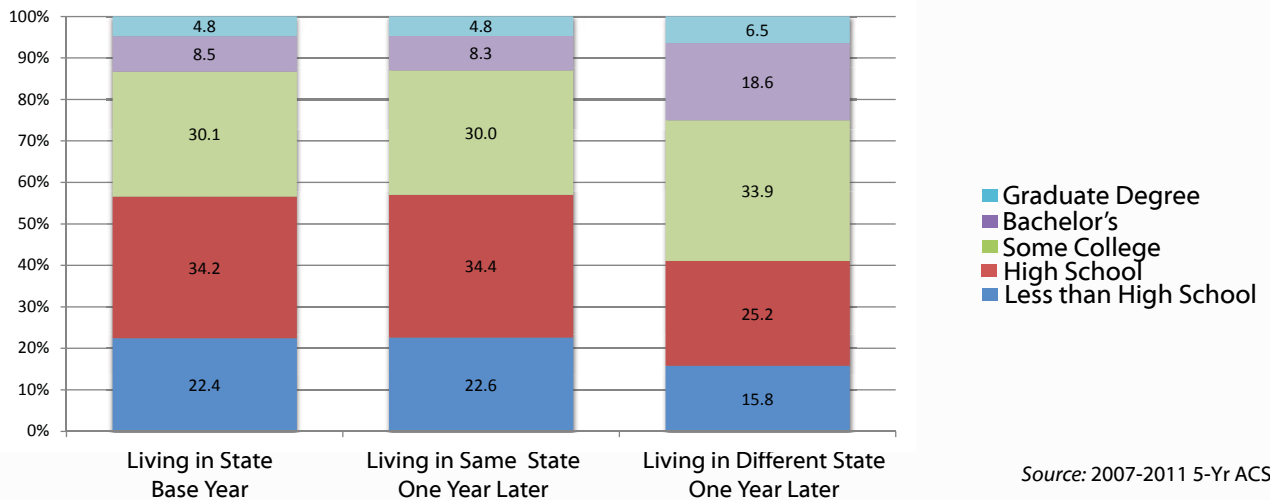

## GEOGRAPHICAL MOBILITY (Over Past Year)



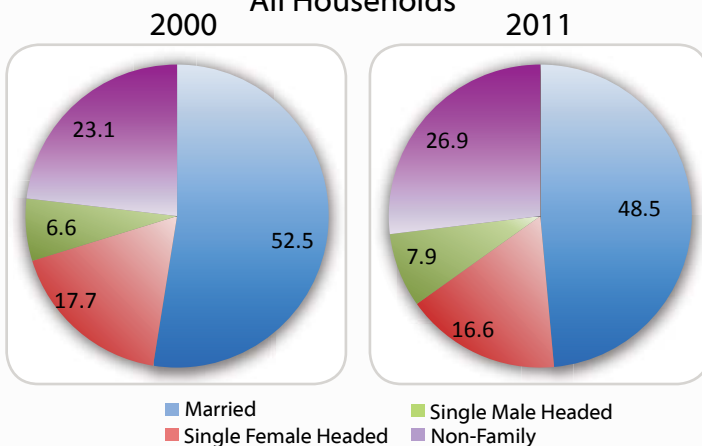
